Please follow registration procedures listed in the back of the catalog. Trip registration is through the Recreation and Community Services Department at Lakewood City Hall. **All trips depart from the Burns Community Center, 5510 Clark Ave. in Lakewood unless otherwise noted.** Participant parking is available in the southeast parking lot of Burns. All destinations are wheelchair accessible unless indicated otherwise. **Please notify us when registering if you use a wheelchair or other mobility aid.** Departure and return times may be adjusted due to certain circumstances beyond our control. Please register early as seating is on a first come, first served basis. Registration is non-transferable. TRAVEL REFUNDS

Refunds will be granted only if the City is notified, the trip is full, and the space can be resold by the City of Lakewood prior to the day of the trip. All three of these conditions must be met to authorize a refund. There is also a \$5 administrative fee per person.

Getty Villa

With breathtaking views of Malibu, the collection and changing exhibitions at the Getty Villa offer 7,000 years of ancient art, from the end of the Stone Age to the fall of the Roman Empire. The Getty Villa houses the J. Paul Getty Museum's collection of approximately 44,000 Greek, Roman, and Etruscan antiquities. Over 1,200 works are on view in 23 galleries devoted to the permanent collection, with five additional galleries for changing exhibitions. With objects dating from 6,500 B.C. to A.D. 400, the collection contains monumental sculptures as well as artifacts of everyday life. There are two onsite eateries for lunch (on your own). Please arrive at 8:15 a.m. for check in. The bus will leave promptly at 8:30 a.m. An adult must accompany children of all ages.

Norton Simon Museum & Old Town Pasadena



The Norton Simon Museum is home to one of the world's most remarkable private art collections ever assembled. Over a 30-year period, the industrialist Norton Simon (1907-1993) amassed an impressive group of European masterworks from the Renaissance to the 20th century, and a stellar collection of South and Southeast Asian art spanning 2,000 years. Modern works from Europe and the United States, acquired by the former Pasadena Art Museum, also occupy an important place in the Museum's holdings. We'll get a private 90-minute tour that will demonstrate the richness and history of the collections. After the tour, you'll have some time on your own to peruse before we head to Old Town Pasadena for lunch and/or shopping (on your own). Backpacks, carriers and purses worn on the back of any size may not be worn in the galleries. Please arrive at 8:15 a.m. The bus will leave promptly at 8:30 a.m. An adult must accompany children of all ages.
